ADMISSION

- Their age in year of entry
- Previous school reports
- Successfully passing the assessment test



Applicant should be 3 years old by August 31st of the academic year in which they are accepted for consideration into PreK.

For applicants looking for admission from KG1 - Grade 1, The age of admission for students is calculated for those who have completed the age approved by KHDA for registration on August 31 of the academic year in which they are accepted.

Following an initial inquiry it is encouraged that parents go on a tour of the school then collect and complete an initial assessment

Parents are required to schedule an assessment with the admissions office. The assessment will be carried out by a designated staff member, and, if appropriate, the Inclusion department. Following Assessment the assessment, we will conduct an interview with designated staff, if required and then parents will receive a decision usually within 3 working days.
